Bred By Exhibitor

Bred-by Exhibitor eligibility; All dogs entered in the Bred By Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with the AKC. The person handling the dog must be the breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog. To Exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

(Involving Single Dog Entries, to be judged after Winners but before Best of Breed.)

Veteran Dog and Veteran Bitch: Open to any dog seven (7) years of age or older, on or prior to the day of the show.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

(Involving Multiple Dog Entries, to be judged after Best of Breed.)

Stud Dog: For Stud Dogs and at least two, but not more than four of their Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not be the owner of the Get. The Stud Dog will be the regular entry, this being the regular entry fee, plus the additional class fee if the Stud Dog is entered in another class. Get only to be judged, based on the merits of the Get. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with his Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its Breed. Each Get must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed Competition or some other Non-Regular Class of the same show. The entry form of each Get must state this competition and requires no additional fee.

Brood Bitch: Same as above except substitute "Brood Bitch" for "Stud Dog", "Produce" for "Get" and "her" for "his".

As the Judge's decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these Classes.

SWEEPSTAKES

The sweepstakes will begin at 6:00 pm on Thursday, February 18, 2010 and is open to any registered AKC Bulldogs at least six (6) months and under 18 months of age on the date of the show. No Champions or dogs holding major wins are eligible. **All entries in Sweepstakes Must be entered in regular class.** Entries must be made at the same time as entries for the regular class on the same form with the word Sweepstakes marked in the Additional Class box. The entry fee due is \$20.00.

From North and South– I-85 to I-385N to Greenville. Take the S. Pleasantburg Drive Exit. Turn on to Tower Diver at second traffic light. Carolina First center will be on your left. Take a left onto Exposition Drive.

From Columbia, SC– I-26 Toward Asheville to I-385 toward Greenville. Follow directions above form I-385

From Asheville, NC –Hwy 25 to Greenville stay on business 25 onto Hwy 291 By-Pass. Left onto Hwy 291. At the first light after crossing Wade Hampton Boulevard turn right, this is still Hwy 291. Cross over I-385 turn left at the second light after crossing I-385 onto Tower Road, then turn left onto Exposition Drive.

IMPORTANT • NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS READ CAREFULLY

- **ENTRY FEES** (includes \$0.50 recording fee and \$3.00 event service fee): \$25 for first entry of each dog, \$22 for 2nd entry of same dog, except Puppy, Bred by Exhibitor Classes and Sweepstakes entries which are \$20. Sweepstakes entries must be entered in a regular class.
- **A RECORDING FEE** of \$0.50 will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. This Recording Fee will be collected by the Clubs and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only (Chapter 11, Sec. 2, AKC Rules).
- **CLOSING DATE** is 12:00PM [EST], Wednesday, February 3, 2010, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules. TELEPHONE, TELEGRAPH, FACSIMILE and UNSIGNED ENTRIES FROM EXHIBITORS CANNOT BE ACCEPTED BY THE SHOW SECRETARY'S OFFICE.
- ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS and PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS **without** the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of Official AKC entry forms are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

- **NO REFUND FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES.** Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made, however, no refund will be made if entry has been processed.

- **THE SHOW SITE WILL BE AVAILABLE TO EXHIBITORS** at discretion of the Show Committee, Thursday, February 18, 2010, until 11:00 PM;
- **SHOW HOURS:** As shown on the Judging Program. Consult Judging Program for time of judging. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it at ring-side when its classes are called to be judged. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.
- **ALL DOGS PRESENT MUST BE HELD ON A LEASH OR CONFINED TO THEIR CRATES** except when being judged.
- **IN ACCORDANCE WITH CHAPTER 11, SEC. 11, AKC RULES APPLYING TO DOG SHOWS:** "Only dogs that are eligible to be shown under The American Kennel Club Rules shall be allowed within the show precincts. There shall be no benching, nor offering for sale or breeding, nor any displaying of unentered dogs." The show-giving clubs will strictly enforce the above-stated rule. Violators will be subject to action by the Event Committee and if found in violation, suspension of AKC privileges may be recommended
- **THERE WILL BE NO SPACE** provided for unentered dogs at this show. The use of private exercise pens will be governed by the Event Committee on the day of the show.
- **GROOMING** dogs in areas other than as designated is not permitted. This will be strictly enforced
- **CLASS CASH PRIZES** will be made in the ring before the judging of the breed is over and the Show Secretary is advised at once. The Secretary and Show-giving clubs disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.
- **ALL TROPHIES MUST BE CLAIMED** the day of the show. Any unclaimed trophies will revert to the general trophy fund after the showing of the breed
- **No dogs or food bowls** in restrooms. Persons found violating this rule are subject to action by the Event Committee.
- **Handicapped facilities** are available.
- **Please obey all posted signs.** Exhibitors must be governed by any rules or regulations of civil authorities. **ALL EXHIBITORS MUST HELP** to maintain this site by assisting in keeping it in excellent condition.
- **ALL EXHIBITORS ARE CHARGED** with the responsibility of cleaning in and around their rooms, vehicles, crates and dogs. Please clean after your dog(s) immediately. Please dispose of all garbage in proper containers.

(Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition; dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owners records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to A.K.C. (For complete rule refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)

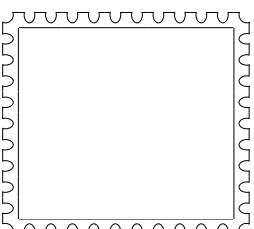

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsman-ship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and com-panion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- ⇒ Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- ⇒ Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- ⇒ Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- ⇒ The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- ⇒ The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- ⇒ The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- ⇒ The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- ⇒ The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- ⇒ Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- ⇒ Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- ⇒ Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- ⇒ Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- ⇒ Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
